## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

My goals for my brief tenure as president of the Virginia Beach Bar Association were relatively modest...avoid botching anything highly visible and important, throw a great banquet party, and make sure that people were generous at the holiday party when it came to the USMC Toys for Tots program (anyone who has served on the Board with me knows how I feel on that issue). And leave the Bar Association in at least as good a condition – organizationally and financially - as I found it. So, let's review.

The Virginia Beach Bar Association was named Bar Association of the Year by the Conference of Local and Specialty Bar Associations. This simply happened while I occupied the role of president. All credit goes to current board members and the previous boards. This was a cumulative effort and a long time coming. The CLASS program, and the efforts on behalf of the Food Bank of Southeastern Virginia played no small part in the consideration.

The Docent Program is back up and running. Judge Quick instigated and oversaw the recreation of the mentorship program for elementary school students, originally started by Judge Shadrick. That program did not cease to exist because of a lack of interest or lack of need; the establishment of the Achievable Dream Program at Seatack Elementary school took care of the need. But the need for mentorship is widespread and is now available in two other elementary schools. We thank all of those who have volunteered and Judge Quick for his efforts and oversight.

The Board and Bar put on a number of well attended CLE's, including the Bench-Bar conference, which will be a yearly event. Peggy Kellam received the Brydges-Russo Distinguished Service Award, which is given based upon merit, not annually, at the Bench-Bar Conference. The two directors (first- and second-year board members) on the Executive Board are responsible for CLE, and I'd like to thank them for their efforts, particularly as the composition of the board shifted, and Wanda Cooper took over for Judge Shupert when she took the bench. Tom Sheppard was present the whole time and did an excellent job of keeping everything on track.

And speaking of judges, we handed out a fair number of gavels this year... Thank you, Judges Bullock, Shupert and Normile for the opportunity to be a part of your investiture ceremonies. Last week the Virginia Beach Bar Association conducted the traditional judicial interview panels and the membership poll for the Circuit Court position made available by Judge Lilley's pending retirement. 
## VBBA JOINT SOCIAL SHRBA

## JUVENILE & DOMESTIC RELATIONS DISTRICT COURT ANNOUNCEMENT


The Juvenile & Domestic Relations District Court wants you to know about the Public Search Terminal available at the Clerk's Office. This computer allows citizens and attorneys to view digital documents in the court's file that are open to the public. If you are a party to a case, you may also request access to view records in juvenile and support cases. Documents that are marked confidential by the clerk cannot be viewed, but other digital documents are available for viewing. There is a reference guide to assist users in the viewing room, but most people find it user-friendly and easy to request copies. Please see a clerk for more information or a demonstration!

## PLEASE BE ADVISED OF THE FOLLOWING NEW JDRC POLICIES:

1. **SIGN-IN SHEETS** – If an attorney is scheduled to be in more than one JDRC courtroom on any given day, the attorney SHALL check into each courtroom prior to the case's docketed time and indicate on the sign-in sheet ALL courtrooms the attorney is scheduled to appear in and his or her estimated return time. If you are an assigned duty attorney for that day, please do not schedule cases outside of JDRC.
2. **CIVIL MOTIONS** – Effective September 15, 2022, an additional civil motion docket will be added for ASSIGNED custody, visitation and support cases. On this docket, civil motions can be docketed from 10:30-11:30 am (formerly 10-11 am) AND 2:00-3:00 pm, on any day that the Judge assigned to the case has duty. The Court does not post Judge schedules. Please file the motion along with all available dates and times for the following three months and a pre-court clerk will be in contact with your office to set the date. Evidence and/or argument will be limited to 30 minutes. Responsive pleadings are welcome, however, notice and filing of "add-on" motions in the same time slot by either party are discouraged and may be stricken from the docket if they cannot be heard within the allotted time.
3. **SEGMENTED DOCKETS** – Effective January 1, 2023, the Court will return to two segmented dockets at 9:00 am and 10:30 am on juvenile, adult criminal, DHS, and civil dockets.


