PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

At the beginning of the year, our Executive Board adopted a mission statement for the Virginia Beach Bar Association. Simply put, our mission is "to be an inclusive and diverse organization that fosters legal excellence, encourages a culture of integrity, honor, collegiality, professionalism, and civility among the bar and the bench, promotes justice and fair play in the legal system, provides public service opportunities to its members, and serves its membership and the public with distinction."

A foundational goal for us, then, is to foster professionalism and civility among the members of our bar and the bench. We work to accomplish that goal in many ways, in large part by offering a broad array of professional education and social events that create opportunities for networking and collegiality.

But perhaps mirroring the coarseness of our country's current civic and political discourse, there has been a steady erosion of civility among litigants and their attorneys in Virginia's courts. Unfortunately, Virginia Beach is no exception to this trend. More needs to be done.

It is undoubtedly difficult for litigants themselves to manage their emotions and maintain their composure during some of life's most stressful moments: Divorces. Child Custody Disputes. Personal Injury Claims. Criminal Prosecutions. Real Estate and Contract Disputes.

It is therefore incumbent upon their legal counsel – all of us – to be the steady hand during their storm. It may not come naturally to us. We invest ourselves professionally and sometimes personally in the outcomes of our cases and the fates of our clients. But we are in the dispute resolution business. We are professionals. Escalating the rhetoric and amplifying the incivility does not serve our shared professional goal of reaching resolution – either in court or outside of it.

For these reasons, on Wednesday, October 10th at the Museum of Contemporary Arts, we will assemble a blue ribbon panel, led by Hon. Glen A. Huff, Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals of Virginia, to renew our focus upon Professionalism & Civility within our profession. We anticipate offering 2.0 hours of Ethics credit, and strong attendance from and participation by our Circuit Court and other benches, who too frequently find themselves refereeing incivility as much as adjudicating disputes.

Similar to the Navy's process after a critical incident, we consider this a safety stand-down of sorts. There are very many of you in our membership to whom we will be "preaching to the choir." But it is a call to all of us to reflect on how we might better serve as part of the solution for our clients, rather than an accelerator of their discord.

We look forward to seeing you at MOCA on October 10th. As always, there will be a cocktail hour, appetizers, and abundant opportunities to connect and confer after the event. And finally, a sincere thanks to each of you for the role you play in ensuring that civility, professionalism, and collegiality remains the hallmark of the Virginia Beach Bar Association.

CONCERNED LAWYERS ADVOCATING SPOUSAL SAFETY (C.L.A.S.S.)






