**IN RE: DISCOVERY IN CRIMINAL AND TRAFFIC CASES**

**ORDER**

Motions for discovery shall comply with Supreme Court of Virginia Rule 7C:5. Each such motion shall have attached thereto a proposed discovery order to be signed by the court. The proposed order shall not seek information beyond that permitted by Rule 7C:5 unless the prosecuting attorney or representative of the Commonwealth have otherwise agreed. If the parties agree, the proposed order shall specify the time, place and manner of making the discovery and inspection permitted by the order. If there is no agreement, then the discovery and inspection permitted by the order shall take place in court on the date set for trial or preliminary hearing but prior to the commencement of said trial or hearing.

All prior orders of this Court pertaining to matters covered by this order are hereby rescinded.
