

VIRGINIA: IN THE GENERAL DISTRICT COURT FOR THE CITY OF HAMPTON


ORDER

Upon consideration of the health and safety of court personnel and the general public, and in response to the recent local metrics regarding the PCR positivity percentage rate of Covid-19 for the city of Hampton, in an effort to reduce the volume of individuals appearing before the court, the court's dockets will be modified starting **January 20, 2021** as follows:

1. Uncontested warrant in debt cases set for a first return in January and February will be continued until March;
2. Traffic cases involving the Hampton Police Department and the Virginia State Police that are currently scheduled for January, February and March will be continued until April;
3. Criminal trials that are currently set will remain on the docket as scheduled but will be allocated to two courtrooms (to be determined by the presiding judge);
4. Protective order hearings will proceed as scheduled;
5. Unlawful detainer actions will remain on the docket as scheduled;
6. Civil trials that are currently set will remain on the docket as scheduled; AND
7. Cases involving the Virginia Marine Police, Hampton Animal Response Team, and Codes and Compliance will remain on the docket as scheduled;
